

Sara Campbell, owner of The Counseling Affect, is a Licensed Professional Counselor who enjoys working with individuals and families affected by autism. Sara is also a mom of a 10 year old boy on the autism spectrum. Throughout her career, Sara has worked in a variety of therapeutic environments, including the Medical Home and Community Basesd Waiver Program. Prior to becoming a Licensed Professional Counselor, Sara practiced rehabilitation counseling.

While Sara offers therapy services to individuals ranging from 4 yrs-65 yrs, she says "My ideal clients are kids that are struggling with Autism, ADHD, Anxiety, Depression or other behavioral issues who need to learn better ways to cope".

At The Counseling Affect Sara also offers Autism Spectrum Training and Parent Education courses. In these courses she provides education and training to parents, families, professionals, and communities, related to differentiating between a meltdown and a tantrum, anxiety and ASD as well as other co-occurring disabilities.

The Counseling Affect recently started offering AutPlay® Therapy. While this might be a term many are not familiar with it seems to have a wide array of benefits. AutPlay Therapy is a play therapy and behavioral therapy-based treatment approach for working with children and adolescents affected by autism spectrum disorder (ASD) and other neurodevelopment disorders. Sara tells us, AutPlay protocol is designed to identify and increase skill deficits and functioning levels in children and adolescents with developmental delays. Typical treatment involves using structured play therapy interventions designed to build relationships, increase engagement, and strengthen skill deficits.
