Sara tells us, AutPlay protocol is designed to identify and increase skill deficits and functioning levels in children and adolescents with developmental delays. Typical treatment involves using structured play therapy interventions designed to build relationships, increase engagement, and strengthen skill deficits.







2020 Grant Focus

As we find ourselves in the midst of a global pandemic, AIM has shifted its focus for this year's AIM2Help Grant Program to sensory items, therapeutic items, and educational materials. We understand that this is a stressful time for the families we serve as routines are changing, days look different than what we are used to, school and some therapies are now taking place at home all of which can cause anxiety and/or behavior concerns. Research shows that sensory play builds nerve connections leading to an increase in a person's ability to complete more complex learning tasks. It also supports cognitive growth, gross and fine motor skills, language development, and problem-solving skills.


